The renovations started last year were completed and the last elements of asbestos removal within the Club finalised. This is a good job put behind us, and means the Club will be asbestos free for any future renovations.

Another good result is that the update of the constitution was finalised. These alterations were to reflect the changes that are ongoing with the SLS movement as a whole and to reflect the structures needed to move forward. These are expensive pieces of vital equipment that require continual maintenance. Trevor & Pete did a great job looking after these.

I would also like to acknowledge our Education & Training Team for the work put in to train lots of new members. The Club had good numbers put through this year and the education and training are really going well.

I must acknowledge an heroic rescue by Madi Rowe assisted by her family, various Club Members & members of the public. Madi put her own life at risk to rescue a local Mum, her daughter & daughter's friend in large surf at Back Beach. Thanks to Madi and the quick responses of our call out team, all parties survived.

With the weather warming early and calm conditions in the surf, competitors started training for positions in the Lower North Coast Interbranch team from early September.
