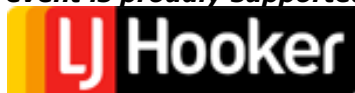

WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry in "Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic":

1. I hereby agree to comply with all of the rules and regulations and event instructions of Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic imposed by the Black Head Surf Life Saving Club and its Officers and organisers.

2. For myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, I hereby waive and release any and all claims I may have against the Black Head Surf Life Saving Club and the organisers of the event, their officers, directors, members, volunteers, agents and sponsors or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors or assigns ("the Releasees") including any and all claims for damage, caused by the negligence of any of them arising out of my participating in the event and its related activities, together with any costs including attorneys' fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not.

3. I hereby indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees and each of them against any such claim that I or my guests or any one or more of my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns may have or assert against any costs including attorneys' fees with respect thereof.

4. I hereby acknowledge that I have the sole responsibility for my personal possessions and effects and any athletic equipment during the Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic event and its related activities.

5. I hereby acknowledge that participation in the Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic competition carries with it potential hazard. I therefore release the Black Head Surf Life Saving Club, its Officers and organisers, volunteers, employees and sponsors of any liability resulting from injury or death during the event and its related activities.

6. I hereby attest and verify that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for this competition and that my physical condition has been verified by a licensed medical doctor.

7. I hereby consent to receive treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during the Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic.

8. I hereby permit the free use of my name and photo in broadcasts, telecasts and the press as they pertain to the event.

9. I understand that my entry fee is non transferable and in the event that I am unable to compete in the Black Head Head2Head Ocean Classic a refund will not be issued.

10. The race committee reserves the right to cancel or postpone the event due to rough or dangerous seas. In the event of cancellation or postponement (by either party) there will be no refund of entry fee

RACE RULES

- All competitors must complete the prescribed course and ensure their name is marked off the official entrants register at the conclusion of the event even if they do not complete the course.
- Swimmers must swim in the race category for which they are eligible.
- All swimmers must wear their prescribed cap.
- A swimmer may use extraneous aids, e.g. Fins, snorkels or flotation clothing or devices in the 700m ocean swim only, but will not be eligible for prizes or qualify as an official place getter, and must notify officials when finishing the event. **NO WETSUITS or any other extraneous aids are permitted**
- All competitors are to behave in a fair and sportsmanlike manner without interference or aggression towards other competitors. Breaches of this rule may result in disqualification.
- If, in the opinion of an event medical officer or a water safety official, a competitor is physically or otherwise incapable of starting or completing the Ocean Swim, or has been in the water for 60 minutes, such competitor may be disqualified from starting or be removed from the water at any time.
- If, in the opinion of the Surf Life Saving Club, the weather or swimming conditions are dangerous or unsuitable, the Ocean Classic may be postponed or cancelled without notice.
- Hi-tech swimsuits are not allowed.
- Ski race competitors are required to wear a PFD at all times during the race, and are encouraged to wear leg leashes.

Risk Warning pursuant to Civil Liability Act 2002 (section 5M)

Ocean swims and ski races are demanding and potentially dangerous events. Risks include drowning, natural obstacles, man-made or controlled obstacles, and marine attack. The Ocean Classic takes place in the open ocean. Swimmers and paddlers enter at their own risk. You should have a medical check prior to entry, and prepare for the event by training. Water safety craft will patrol the course for the duration of the event. If a competitor feels unable to proceed further in the event, the attention of the water safety personnel should be sought. The Ocean Classic organizers cannot guarantee your safety. The Ocean Classic organizers reserve the right to bring to shore by the water patrol any entrants which they deem to be incapable of competing further in the event. While in the competition area - including the beach and water environments - entrants must follow all directions of Lifeguards and Ocean Classic organizer's officials and water safety personnel.
