



#### CAPTAIN'S REPORT

The 1991/92 season was a slightly quieter year than last season but still saw 101 active members on the last patrol roster, with several new squads still to come. 33 members obtained 100% attendance of their rostered patrols.

A very quiet year on the rescue and first aid scene, with 88 preventative actions, 6 rescues without gear, 2 rescues with the board, 1 lacerated foot, and 1 suspected spinal injury with the ambulance in attendance. An other major rescue was performed on a 40cm long brown snake which happened to be sunning itself (between the flags).

Our season started out pretty well with our boat crews and ski team competing in the Wallingat to Winda Woppa Surf Boat Marathon both outfits performed very well. When you compete in an event such as this you get to know what friendship and club spirit is all about.

Members competed at all Carnivals in our Branch, and throughout the State including Country, State and Australian Championships.

We also retained the Branch Championship title for the 4th consecutive year, well done, a good club effort.

Black Head's I.R.B. Team regained the Branch Title from Cape Hawke with a clean sweep of all events. They also went on to represent the Branch in the AMP Challenge at Manly coming 6th in the State. Then to the State Championships also at Manly where they picked up a Bronze Medal in the B Tube Rescue. This was followed by winning 3 Silver and 2 Bronze medals at the Country Branches I.R.B. Championships.

This year saw our first defeat in our Veterans Carnival which was won by Newcastle S.L.S.C. by the barest of margins, maybe next year we can reverse the decision


