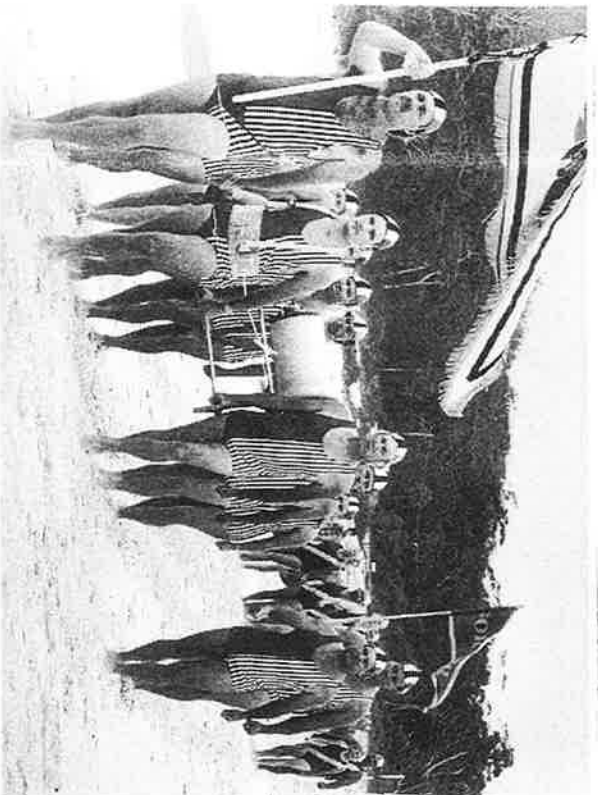

CAPTAINS REPORT

This year as in other years Black Head Beach was patrolled by a dedicated and vigilant group of members, resulting in only 9 rescues in the 94-95 season with 139 preventative actions.

The backbone of every club are its patrol members and this year we had 38 members who did not miss a rostered patrol, these members are to be congratulated.

At the end of last season a group of girls decided that they would turn themselves into boaties and they certainly did this with great results, sweeping all before them. The girls started out with a win in the inaugural Forster short course marathon. Then they went into the North Coast Boat Series as two teams, there they ended the series in first and second place. The 'A' team also won a medal at the N.S.W. Country titles. The girls must be congratulated for their dedication to training and the way that they represented the club at the carnivals.

The branch carnival this year was a great effort from the people who turned up to take on the might of Forster, the effort put in was outstanding and we gave Forster a run for the title unfortunately we fell a few points shy of the shield. Tim Manusu must be given a special mention for winning 16 gold medals over the two branch carnivals (surf & IRB).

Our IRB team once again blitzed the opposition at the branch winning all events except one. At the N.S.W. Country titles they won a swag of medals and at state they won a silver medal. I would like to thank Mick Cross for his assistance in helping me with the running of water safety, carnivals and events held at our beach where the IRB was required.

A large number of clubs participated at our annual veterans carnival resulting in more competitors and closer competition. The day was a large success with all the clubs wanting to come back next year. 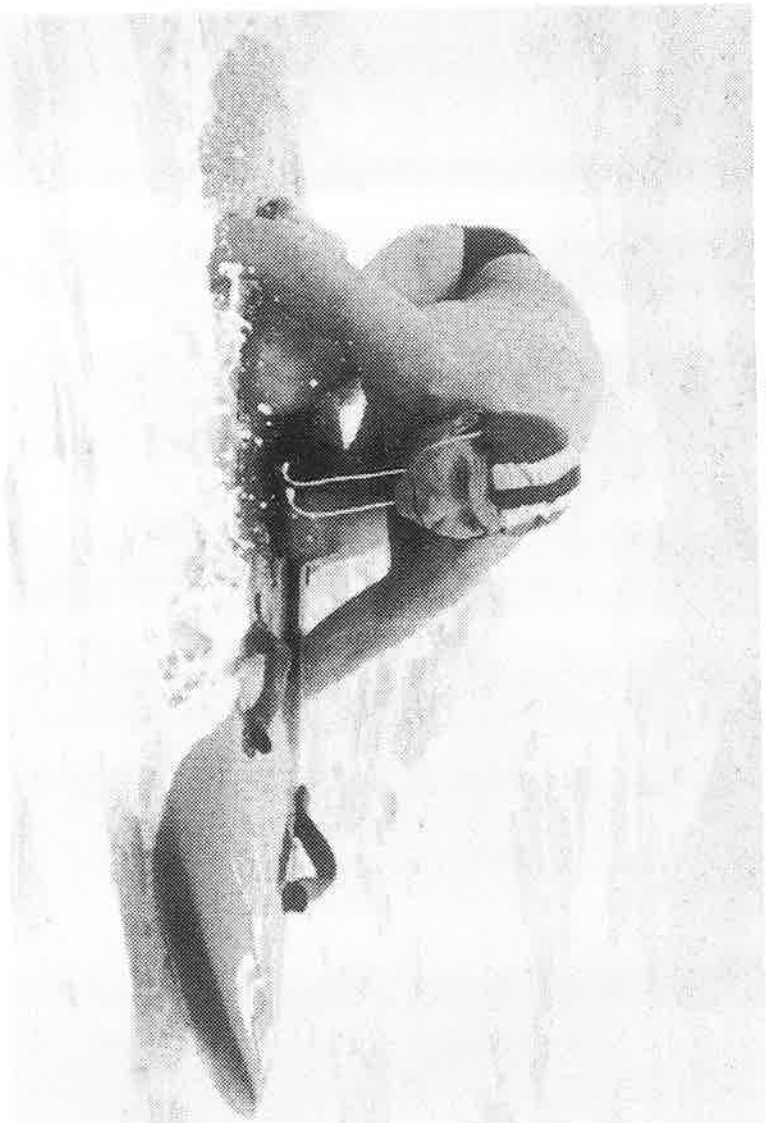
Congratulations to all members who were successful in gaining awards over the past season.

IRB CAPTAINS REPORT

The 1994-95 season has been another very successful one for the IRB Team.

The year was highlighted by a win in the Overall Pointscore at the Country Championships held at Cape Hawke in June. This is a great achievement and proves that Black Head has the best IRB Team in Country NSW. Black Head finished the Carnival with 3 Gold, 2 Silver and 3 Bronze medals.

The Branch IRB Championships once again showed the dominance of Black Head in IRB competition in the Lower North Coast Branch. Black Head won 12 of the 13 events contested with a minor fuel tank problem the only thing preventing a clean sweep of the Carnival.

At the NSW IRB Championships Black Head qualified for the finals of 4 events and the semi-finals in 4 events. The 'B' Grade Rescue Tube crew finished 2nd and picked up the silver medal.

The Australian IRB Championships was a carnival of mixed fortunes for the IRB Team. We contested the Rescue Tube, Assembly, Team and Rescue events, qualifying for 2 quarter finals and 2 semi-finals. A blown power pack while leading the quarter of the Team Event put an end to our best medal hope.

The Branch Championships were held at Black Head, once again we came second to Forster, although we were much closer this year.

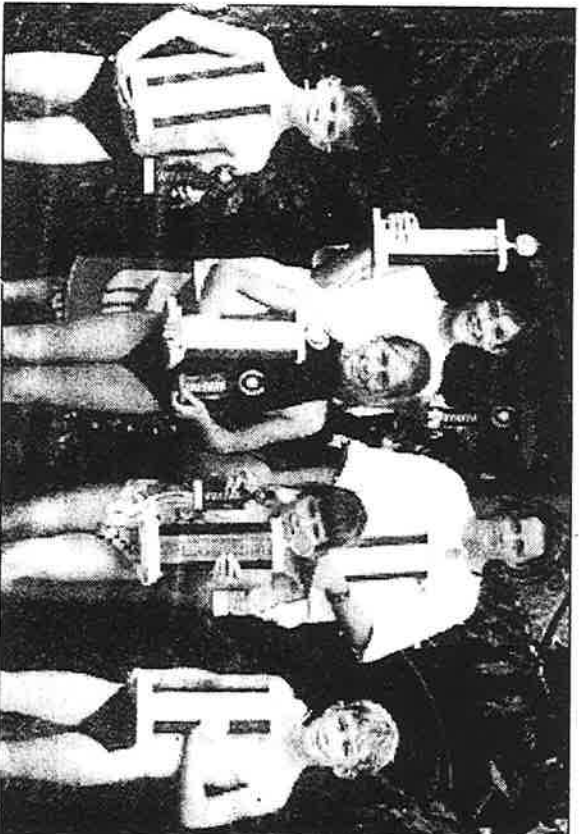
The State Championships at Mollymook saw three children travel south, with excellent results, Jessica Hamilton the Bronze medal in the Under 10 girls sprint, a great result.

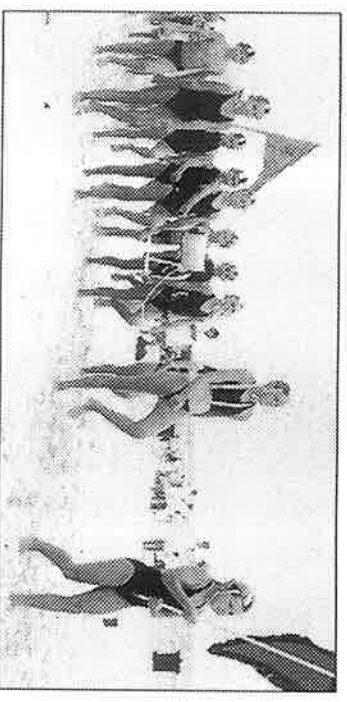
